Annexure – I

Background

Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (GCMMF) is engaged in marketing of milk and milk products packed in poly pouches in the state of Gujarat under the brand name “AMUL”. AmulFed Dairy is the manufacturing unit of GCMMF, having plant with state of the art manufacturing capacity at village Bhat, district Gandhinagar.

As per plastic waste management rules 2016, it is responsibility of producer and brand owner to establish a mechanism for disposal of plastic waste generated due to its products i.e. Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR).

AmulFed Dairy intends to meet its EPR obligation of recycling 1500 MT/annum PE poly pouches from Ahmedabad market. Offers are invited for establishing the complete mechanism of recycling the plastic waste generated due to milk and milk products in poly pouches. Detailed scope of work shall be as under:

Scope of Work

- Establishing a mechanism for collection of post-consumer waste generated by households through appropriate channel like - waste pickers, waste aggregators, scrap dealers, commercial establishments, AMUL parlours, road litters etc. and transportation to processing facility through adequate capacity vehicles.
- Sorting and processing of waste at their facility – Recyclable PE Material. The facility must have GPCB consent of adequate capacity at least equivalent to the take back quantity offered by the bidder.
- Dispatch of waste for Recycling in suitable market acceptable forms such as granules/lumps.
- Provide take back credits equivalent to Metric Tons of PE Plastic recycled
- Provide EPR Certificate stating quantum of waste diverted from land filling, tons of CO₂ emissions mitigated and energy saved which can be submitted to the Pollution Control Board.
- Provide a detailed activity report on established channels, Nos. of waste pickers engaged for take back system and quantity of recycling established in state of implementation.
- Creating awareness of consumers for recycling of plastic waste through suitable mass media like advertisements, workshops, hoardings at Amul parlours etc.
- Mention the AFD's initiative in different EPR Forums across the country.
- Preparation of Action Plan to meet EPR obligation as per format of Urban Development, assistance for endorsement of action plan by concerned government authority and obtaining plastic waste registration for AmulFed Dairy (AFD).



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Notes:

1. Bidder can submit the offer for quantity to be recycled as per their available consent. However, minimum capacity should be 500 MT/annum.
2. Bidders should have valid GPCB approval and will be responsible for any query related to GPCB.
3. Certificate submitted to AFD must have traceability to actual quantity of waste pick up for AMUL.
4. Bidder shall submit certificate on monthly for recycled quantity as per our liability of recycle quantity. We may submit the same to GPCB if require. GPCB may also enquire with your for the same. Vendor should be responsible for any query related to recycling of plastic in behalf of AFD.
5. Minimum term of contract shall be one year.
6. Offer should be given on per kg of waste handled basis i.e. INR/kg of waste recycled as per below format
7. Successful bidder shall enter in MOU with AmulFed Dairy, Gandhinagar mentioning therein the commitment for quantity of recycling.

Payment Terms:

Invoice will be made on fortnightly basis with evidence (in the form of EPR certificate) of PE collected and recycled.

Payment will be made within 15 days of receipt of invoice.
